BY-LAW NO. 2019-35

"A BY-LAW TO DESIGNATE HALF LOAD RESTRICTIONS ON ROADS WITHIN THE BOUNDARIES OF THE TOWNSHIP OF EDWARDSBURGH CARDINAL"

WHEREAS Section 122 (7) of the Highway Traffic Act, R.S.O. 1990, as amended, provides that a municipality or other authority having jurisdiction over a highway, may by by-law, designate the date on which a reduced load period shall start or end, and the highway or portion thereof, under its jurisdiction to which the designation applies; and

WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Edwardsburgh Cardinal deems it advisable to designate a half load restrictions period for the protection of highways under the jurisdiction of the Township of Edwardsburgh Cardinal;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Edwardsburgh/Cardinal enacts as follows:

- The provisions of Section 122 of the Highway Traffic Act, apply to all highways under the jurisdiction of the Township of Edwardsburgh Cardinal, during the period from the first (1st) day of March to the thirtieth (30th) day of April inclusive, in each and every year, and may be extended when deemed necessary and authorized by the Roads Superintendent.
- 2. The provisions of Section 122 of the Highway Traffic Act shall also apply to various roads under the jurisdiction of the Township of Edwardsburgh Cardinal at such other times during the year as may be deemed necessary and authorized by the Roads Superintendent.
- 3. This By-law shall become effective when appropriate signage has been erected, in a conspicuous place on the affected road(s).
- 4. That all other by-laws previously passed that are inconsistent with the provisions of this by-law are hereby repealed.
- 5. That this by-law shall come into force and take effect on the date of passing.
